Grantmakers cannot always afford to go it alone to achieve their goals in international grantmaking in this economic climate. Many seek like-minded individuals, family and private foundations to share financial obligations and due diligence on international grants. Matching funds, sharing grantee information, and aligning program objectives are ways grantmakers can leverage limited resources and staff.



Anne McEnany with the International Community Foundation and Theresa Rhodes with the United Nations Foundation discuss how working through intermediary grantmakers can give grantmakers the technical advice and grant administration services they need. Gabby Anaya with Baja Funders Group shares how funder collaboratives allow grantmakers to learn from their peers, share their strategies, and provide/seek matching funding. This session highlights three organizations that can help grantmakers in the Midwest leverage their international impact.
